

Nouns - IIA

Use the indefinite article “a” before words beginning with a consonant sound (or closed sound). Use “an” before words beginning with a vowel sound (or open sound).

Note to teacher: There are four noun boxes beginning with Roman Numeral II. Roman Numeral I is a set of words from all parts of speech learned in the previous grammar lessons—the “Function of Words.”
